## From the Pastor's Desk....

### A FEW FINAL THOUGHTS

I have been overwhelmed at the number of cards, the generosity of so many gifts and the heartfelt expressions of appreciation and gratitude which I have received and heard on the occasion of my 75<sup>th</sup> Birthday and the announcement of my retiring. It's hard to believe that twenty years have passed since my coming to St. Patrick's and extremely gratifying to know that I have made an impact on so many lives. These last two weeks have been more than hectic as I prepare to turn the reins over to your new pastor, Fr. Joseph Bisignano, and to get myself moved out and down to the Cardinal O'Connor Clergy Residence. Please be patient with me as I have had practically no time to formally acknowledge your cards and gifts; that will be my first priority once I arrive at Camp Marist this weekend. However, there are a few items that I would like to share with you.

When the Parish Council asked me what kind of "going away" gift I would like to receive from the parish I asked that a **Monument to the Unborn** be placed to the left of the entrance to the New Church. As you know, the cause of Respect Life has been a very important one in my time here, reflected in my support of and participation in the Respect Life Organization, the March for Life in Washington, D.C., the Gabriel Project, the Midnight Run, the Sharing Community and other similar programs. A Monument to the Unborn is something several of us have spoken about but never quite got accomplished. Nothing would please me more than to have one in place in the near future. So an *ad hoc* committee has been established to research the many forms which it could take and then to decide on one. When that task is completed, a poster bearing a rendition of the monument will be placed in the entrance of both churches along with a formal request for contributions. Should you wish to make a donation prior to that time, please make out a check to "St. Patrick's Parish" and enter the words *Monument to the Unborn* on the MEMO line of your check. If your donation is in cash, please be sure to include your name and address. A Donor's Book will be kept of the contributors and presented to me as my

"going away" present, for which I will be eternally grateful.

A few words about your new pastor. Fr. Bisignano is fifty-five years old and a member of the 1981 Ordination Class from St. Joseph's Seminary in Yonkers. He has been the pastor of St. Joachim and St. John the Evangelist Parish in Beacon, N.Y. for the past ten years. It was his task to combine those two parishes in such a fashion as to try to please all concerned, and he fought hard to keep the parish school open prior to its closing. He therefore revealed a good degree of sensitivity to his parishioners and a strong commitment to Catholic education. He is also the elected representative of the priests of Dutchess county to the Archdiocesan Priest' Council, indicating the esteem in which he is held by his fellow priests. I am confident that it is the Holy Spirit who has sent him to you and that he will support the remarkable work that so many of you have done and want to continue doing. Without doubt, *The Spirit of St. Patrick's* will be renewed and continue to reveal itself in a whole host of wonderful ways.

As for myself, as of August 1<sup>st</sup> I will be living at the Cardinal O'Connor Clergy Residence, 5655 Arlington Ave., Bronx, N.Y. 10471. There are thirty-two other priests in residence there so I will have plenty of company. I will have my own living quarters and share a lovely dining room and chapel. Most important, I will have my own parking space! You know that I will not be just "sitting around."

I want to do some traveling around the country to visit people I haven't seen in years, there are several projects I am considering that will keep me busy, and I have in mind a book I want to write on the priesthood. Most important, I will be doing what I want to do when I want to do it because that's what retirement is all about! Through it all you may be very sure that you and your loved ones will always be in my prayers and I ask only that you keep me in yours. God bless.
