**INSTALLATION OF OUR NEW PASTOR
FR. JOSEPH F. J. BISIGNANO**

What, exactly, is the “Installation of a New Pastor?”

“In its precise sense, an installation is the formal seating of a canon in his cathedral stall, symbolizing conferral of his office. The term also is used broadly for inauguration into any ecclesiastical office: for taking ‘canonical possession’ of a diocese by a Roman Catholic Bishop or of a parish by a pastor; as an Anglican term, enthronement of a bishop or induction of a rector. Lutherans, Presbyterians, Baptists, and others in the United States of America frequently call the public recognition of a new minister or church officer an installation.” (Encyclopedic Dictionary of Religion)

The Book of Blessings in its Appendix 1 has the following introduction:

- 2012 When a new pastor is appointed for a parish it is appropriate that he be publicly installed by a liturgical rite. The installation should, if possible, take place at one of the Masses on the first Sunday that his appointment is effective. The installation may also take place during a celebration of the Word of God, or during Morning or Evening Prayer.
- 2013 The bishop is the usual celebrant of this rite. However, he may delegate a priest to preside in his place, e.g., a vicar or a dean. In this case, the *Order of Installation Within Mass When a Priest Presides* is used.
- 2016 The members of the Parish Council, the Finance Council, and the parish trustees should be seated in the front of the church and, if desired, they may take part of the entrance procession.

2018 The required oaths are signed after Mass.

2019 The new pastor may briefly address the people immediately after the prayer after communion.

With the above being true, adaptations are permissible and even desired. The Archbishop rarely does installations himself because his schedule does not allow him the time. It is usually the local Episcopal Vicar (bishop) or the Regional Vicar (priest) who presides. In our case, our Regional Vicar, Rev. Msgr. George Thompson, has allowed me to invite a personal friend, Bishop Dominick Lagonegro, to preside.

Bishop Dominick has chosen to preside and not concelebrate. When a Bishop concelebrates, he must be the main celebrant since he has received the fullness of Orders. In order to allow the new pastor to be the main celebrant after he has been seated in the chair, the bishop prefers to preside. Therefore, he will have the main seat for the Liturgy of the Word and for the actual installation but then he will take a chair and kneeler off to the side for the rest of the celebration.

The actual installation includes the invocation of the Holy Spirit; the reading of the Letter of Appointment; the presentation of the parish staff; the presentation of the Parish Council, the Finance Council and the Trustees; the presentation of the Symbols of the Pastoral Office; reverence of the Altar; profession of Faith and Oath; General Intercessions; seating of the new pastor.
