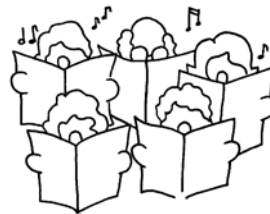

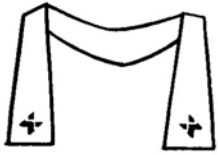

## Vestment Memorials Available

If you would like to remember a loved one with a very special memorial, we have five new sets of vestments that may be memorialized. Each set consists of four pieces, a Chasuble and Stole, a Deacon Stole, a Chalice Veil and a Burse. The colors are:

**White:** Used for the Christmas and Easter seasons and for most Saints days.

**Green:** Used for Ordinary Time.

**Advent Violet:** Used during the Advent Season.

**Lenten Violet:** Used during the Lenten Season.

**Red:** Used for Pentecost, Passion/Palm Sunday, Good Friday, Feasts of the Apostles and Martyrs, Votive Masses of the Holy Spirit, and for Confirmation.

These Vestments will be on display in the Vestibule of the New Church this coming week. The cost for each set is \$650.00. The items are only available as a complete set. The Memorial label will be affixed to the Chasuble. If you are interested in this memorial, please call the Rectory.
