My husband and I have been involved in "TEAMS" for 14 years so far! It was a great way to meet other Catholic couples, especially in such a large parish, when we moved here 15 years ago with 3 small children!

Being on a "TEAM" has been a very rewarding experience for us. We have received much ENCOURAGEMENT and STRENGTH through the PRAYERS and FELLOWSHIP of the "TEAMS COMMUNITY"through medical difficulties, challenges of raising our children in this increasingly secular world, work-related stresses, and especially being "upheld" during the suffering and death of my father 6 years ago. We have shared in the joys of Baptisms, 1st Communions, Confirmations, birthdays and anniversaries!! The "TEAM Community" has become like FAMILY TO US...A GIFT from GOD!

We would like to present this "gift" to other couples! There are few Teams in our parish that have room to add 1-2 new couples, and if there enough interest, we'd love to see some NEW TEAMS develop!! Couples who might be interested in joining a Team can "try it out" for 4 months before making the commitment to stay on the Team for a year. Each NEW TEAM will have a "PILOT" couple, a couple from an existing TEAM who will attend the first 4 meetings with the new Team, to GUIDE them through a typical meeting, so they will be comfortable to continue on their own. We will also be available to help out in whatever way we can as "Sector Couple" for the Northern Westchester area!

We plan to hold an "INFORMATION NIGHT" on SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 12TH, at 6:00 PM,(immediately following the 5PM MASS), in the lower Parish Center Meeting Room, to answer any of your questions!
