Monsignor Brennan's 50th Anniversary Ordination will be celebrated on **Sunday, June 4th** at the 12:30 Mass with a reception to follow.

Msgr. Brennan's Retirement Gift Msgr. Brennan retired as Pastor of St. Patrick's last July 1st. At this time, the Parish Council, in the name of the entire parish, presented him with a gift of a **Monument to the Unborn** to be dedicated in his honor. A committee of Parish Council and Respect Life Committee members has developed the appearance of the stone, the inscription and a text of dedication. An illustration of the Monument is on display in the vestibule of both churches. The total cost will be \$8,000, of which \$2,300 has already been donated.
