Dear Padre

Where do non-Biblical stories of the Holy Family come from?

I have heard priests say things about Jesus' childhood, the Blessed Virgin, Saint Joseph, or Saint Ann, and none of these things are in the Bible. Do they just make these things up? Where do these stories come from?

Dear Jude,

There were a lot of things written around the time of the gospels that are not part of the Bible. I suspect that many of the stories you hear, especially about the people you mention, come from these sources.

In the early days of the Church, people were eager to hear as much as they could about Jesus and his family. Many things about the childhood of Jesus, or the life of Saint Joseph and our Blessed Mother, were written down. For example, there are many things about the family of Mary and about Joseph in a work called the Gospel of James.

This is not revelation like the Scriptures, but they were stories that people remembered and that were written down. Things that we now call legends about Jesus or Mary were collected in a variety of written accounts. They have been passed down through the ages because they often help make an important point about Christian life.

All that we need for salvation is revealed to us in the Scriptures. These tidbits about Jesus, Mary, or Joseph from these other sources can add color and flavor, but remember, they are not revealed by God.
