Main Church

The lower level of the Church is beginning to experience a substantial penetration of water along our south west perimeter masonry wall, i.e. the section of wall which runs parallel to the Hanover Street access drive. Subsequent to heavy rains, water collects at the base of the stair case leading to the Parish Center. Penetration will occur when ground water rises above the floor slab or when the foundation is subject to hydrostatic pressure. Initial relief will be implemented consisting of: land slope stabilization, repair of exposed building face surfaces, in general, and lastly nominal sub-surface work.

Given the relatively young age of the Church, constructed only 22 years ago, the aforementioned presence of water at the lower level is most revealing. That said, other areas of the Church in need of upgrading as well our total building premises, in general, will be addressed in the near future.
